GENERAL ORDER

RE: Reassignment of Business Court Cases and Equalization of Caseloads

WHEREAS, by Order dated April 9, 2019 (2019-13), the Kentucky Supreme Court authorized a pilot project for the implementation of a Business Court Docket in Jefferson Circuit Court; and,

WHEREAS, due to retirement and the 2022 judicial elections, it has become necessary to appoint new judges to fill the role of Business Court Judges in Jefferson County;

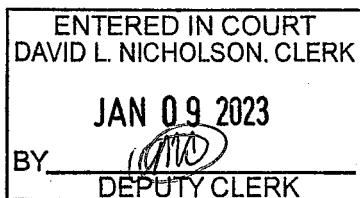
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, as soon as practical, the Jefferson County Office of the Circuit Court Clerk (OCCC) will reassign, with notice to all parties, all active Business Court (BC) Cases as follows:

- Division 4, former Circuit Judge Charles Cunningham's active BC cases are hereby reassigned to Division 3, Chief Circuit Judge Mitch Perry; and,
- Division 10, former Circuit Judge Angela Bisig's active BC cases are hereby reassigned to Division 1, Circuit Judge Eric Haner;

FURTHER, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, to equalize the caseloads of the respective courts due to the reassignment of the Business Court Cases, the OCCC is directed to reassign an equal number of new 2023 Circuit Civil Filings as follows:

- When the next 29 General jurisdiction civil cases (that is, non-BC cases) are randomly assigned to Division 1, Circuit Judge Eric Haner, they will be automatically reassigned to Division 10 to account for the BC cases transferred as noted herein;
- When the next 43 general jurisdiction civil cases (that is, non-BC cases) are randomly assigned to Division 3, they will be automatically reassigned to Division 4 to account for the BC cases transferred as noted herein.
